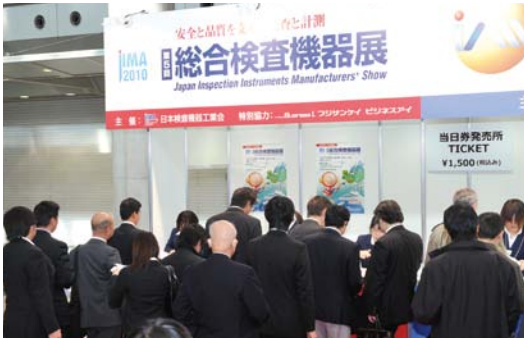
Visitor categories

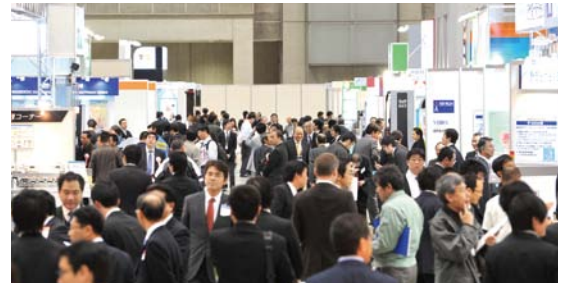

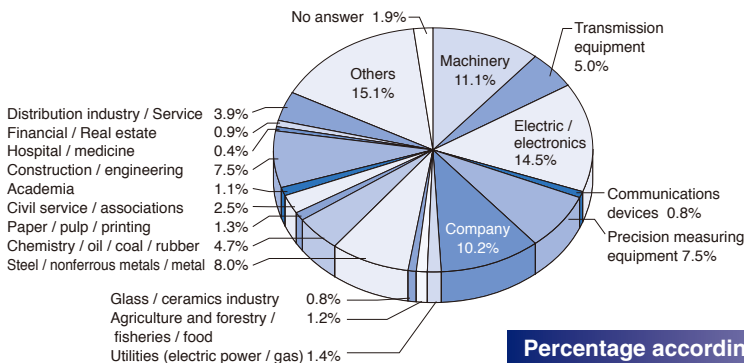

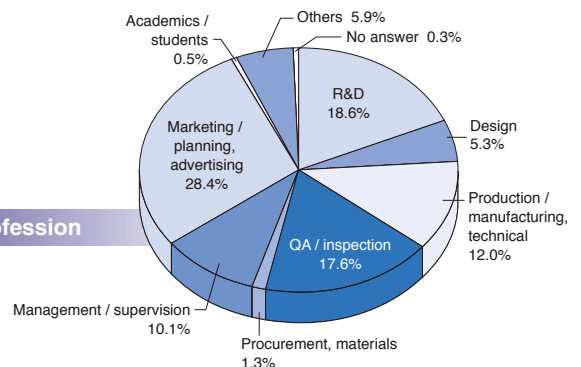


- **Types of visitor**
