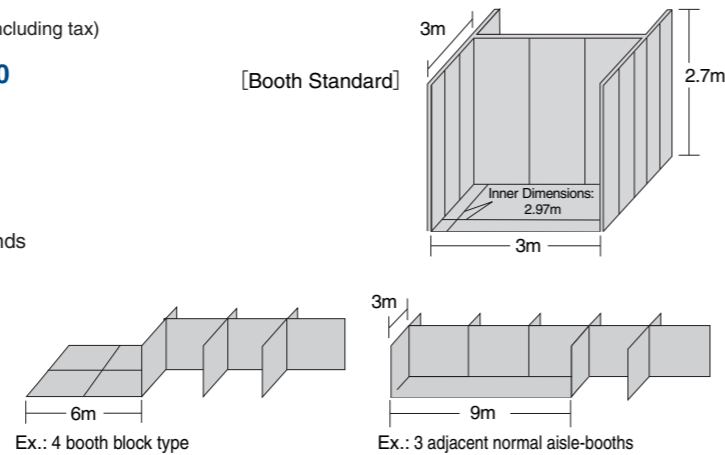

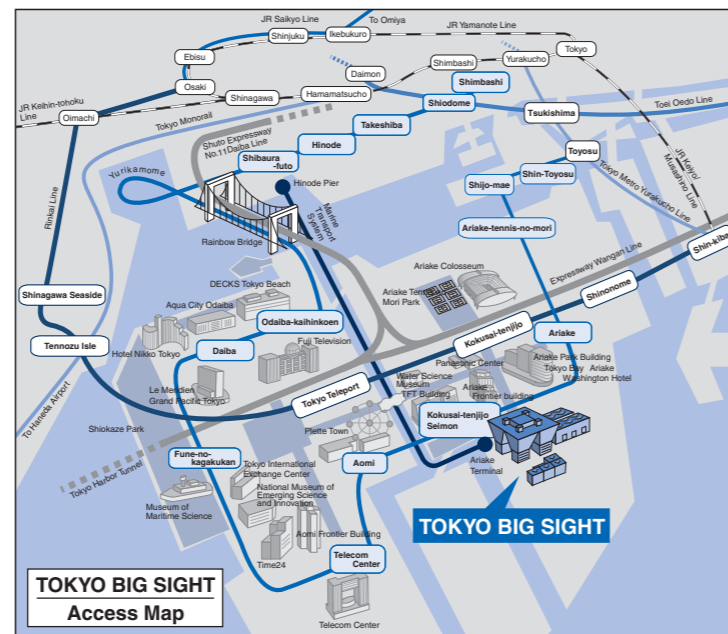

### Visitor categories

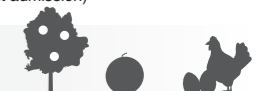
All the manufacturing industries and safety maintenance engaged in inspection, measurement, testing and evaluation.

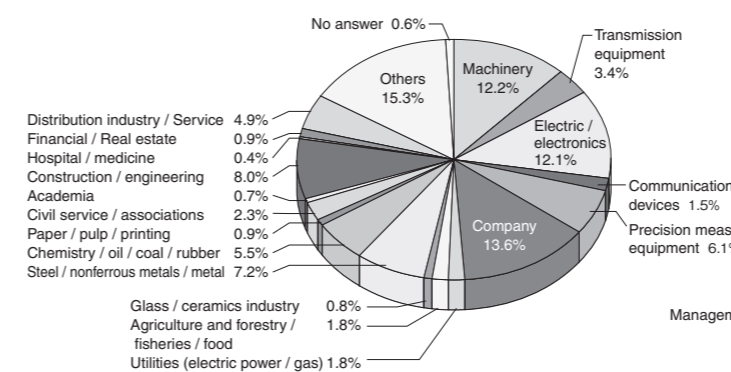

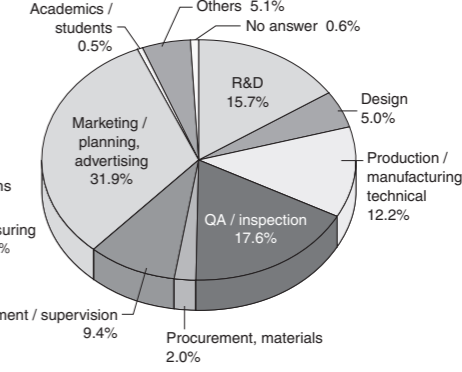
